I love this quilt pattern! I had a photo saved for a similar quilt for years, and finally, I decided to draft my own pattern for it. This quilt fits my King Size bed, and I look forward to taking it out year after year to celebrate the Fourth of July! It is composed of stripes, and Sawtooth Star Quilt Blocks using the Fast Flying Geese Method! I'm calling this quilt, "Americana."



To make the Sawtooth Star Block, and the Double Sawtooth Star Block, you will need to use the Fast Flying Geese Method. This method uses less fabric, and is a quick easy way to make the "flying geese" edges that form the Sawtooth Star block. The large "goose squares" are sewn to the "sky squares" which are then cut into a flying geese block pattern. Sky Squares
$2.5^{\prime \prime} \times 2.5^{\prime \prime}$
4.25 " x 4.25 "
$3.5^{\prime \prime} \times 3.5^{\prime \prime}$
2" x 2"

D: Navy Bar
$3.5^{\prime \prime} \times 12.5^{\prime \prime}$
Cut 14


Outer Edges of Your Blocks (Flying Geese)
E: Gray Corner Square
$3.5^{\prime \prime} \times 3.5^{\prime \prime}$
Cut 56
F: Gray Goose Square*
7.25" x 7.25"
Cut 14
G: Navy Sky Square*
4" x 4"
Cut 84
H: White Corner
$3.5^{\prime \prime} \times 3.5^{\prime \prime}$
Cut 28
Square
I: White Goose Square*
7.25" x 7.25"
Cut 7

## J: 6x6 Red and White Center Startooth Block

J.1: White Center Square
$3.5^{\prime \prime} \times 3.5^{\prime \prime}$

K: $6 \times 6$ Navy and Bright Blue Center 4-Square Block
